We write to provide you with the attached map, which sets out the Musgamagw-Dzawada'enuxw traditional territory, shared by the collectives of the Dzawada'enuxw, Kwicksutainuek, Haxwa'mis and Gwawaenuk peoples.

The lands and waters within the boundary outlined in the map are exclusive to the Musgamagw-Dzawada'enuxw, based on our historical use, occupation and governance. As such, only the Musgamagw-Dzawada'enuxw have the authority to speak for, and act as stewards of, these lands and waters. For greater clarity, this map does not include non-exclusive resource harvesting areas accessed by the Musgamagw-Dzawada'enuxw.
