

We write to provide you with the attached map, which sets out the *Musgamagw-Dzawada'enuxw* traditional territory, shared by the collectives of the Dzawada'enuxw, Kwicksutainuek, Haxwa'mis and Gwawaenuk peoples.

The lands and waters within the boundary outlined in the map are exclusive to the *Musgamagw-Dzawada'enuxw*, based on our historical use, occupation and governance. As such, only the *Musgamagw-Dzawada'enuxw* have the authority to speak for, and act as stewards of, these lands and waters. For greater clarity, this map does not include non-exclusive resource harvesting areas accessed by the *Musgamagw-Dzawada'enuxw*.
